

2015 Scholarship Opportunities

What is a Scholarship?

A scholarship is financial support awarded by an academic institution to a student on the basis of academic merit. At Henley Business School we award a limited number of scholarships on our MBA programme to students who have achieved excellence in their prior academic studies. A key consideration in our selection of Scholarship awards will therefore be the degree to which we believe the candidate will make a significant contribution to the quality of the Henley MBA programme. It is likely that award winners will have a UK first class Honours Degree or its international equivalent from a reputable, leading University or academic institution. Scholarship applications are considered by an academic panel of Henley Business School and their decision is final and not open to discussion or appeal by applicants.

Henley Business School Scholarships for 2015

Applications are invited for the following Scholarships on our MBA programmes

- Full-time MBA Programme 2 x 100% awards
- Executive MBA Programme 2 x 50% awards
- Flexible Executive MBA Programme 2 x 50% awards

The 2015 Scholarship Application Process

All applicants for the Henley MBA in 2015 who submit full and complete applications and receive an unconditional offer of a place on the Henley MBA for 2015 will be automatically considered for a Scholarship. You must therefore have received an unconditional offer from Henley Business School before the following deadlines in order to be considered by the panel.

Application Deadlines

- Flexible Executive MBA March intake – Friday 20th February 2015
- Full-time MBA – Friday 29th May 2015
- Flexible Executive MBA – Monday 29th June 2015
- Flexible Executive MBA Sept intake – Friday 31st July 2015

1. Submission of the MBA Application form, 2 references, copy of degree transcripts, CV and any other supporting documents. See full MBA application procedures.
